Candidates for President and U.S. Congress Pledge to Support both:

A U.S. Balanced Budget Amendment that at a minimum:

- Prohibits total federal spending from increasing faster than inflation up to 2% plus population growth with exceptions for Social Security and national emergencies.
- Stipulates the state convention mode of ratification (a vote of the people).

The Let Us Vote for a Balanced Budget Amendment Resolution that:

- Sets the time and place ("call") for an Article V Convention of States to propose a U.S. Balanced Budget Amendment upon receipt of 34 BBA or Any-Subject Applications. (Note: there are currently 33 Article V Applications: 27 BBA & 6 on Any-Subject)
- Voids any convention-proposed amendment unrelated to balancing the federal budget
- Stipulates the state convention mode of ratification (a vote of the people).
